

# DSA PREP Workshop

## Overall guideline:

Try your best to **engage** your interviewers and leave a **good first impression** on them! Showcase your **strong interest** in their school. Come well-prepared for the interview, by conducting **Research** on the school's history, school values and motto, extracurricular activities and more! Try to give examples of **outstanding** achievements you have accomplished, while remaining **humble** at the same time. Try to present yourself **genuinely** but do not leave an impression that you have a bad personality on the interviewers. Interviewers are not only looking for talented students or keen interest in becoming students of their school – They are also looking for potential leaders and role models for the rest of the cohort, as well as students who will project a positive image for the school. Lastly, give **unique/expressive** responses with relevant **details** for personal questions. This will create a better understanding of your character, leaving a deeper impression of you on your interviewers, making you stand out from the rest!

Segment	Details
INTRODUCTION	Rapport building Self-Introduction Sharing session
FUNDAMENTALS OF SPEECH	Assessing participant's confidence level, eye contact, voice tonality, hand gestures, and body language.
PRACTICE	Interactive session between participant and personal trainer. Participant will also undergo a mock interview session, as a potential DSA interviewee.
SPEECH REFINEMENT	Refinement & rehearsal of homework given by the trainer. Advanced coaching on skills application in the answering interview questions (B.E.S.T TECHNIQUES, P.R.E.P TECHNIQUES).
HOMEWORK	Preparation for Crucial Questions that examiners will ask
